2. **EQUIPMENT**
 - 2.1 Tables (Double Happiness)
 - 2.2 Balls (White, Double Happiness ★★★)

3. **COMPETITION AND PRACTICE HALLS**
 - 3.1 Competition Hall – Sports Hall, Shaw Sports Complex, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, Hunghom, Kowloon, Hong Kong, China
 - 3.2 Practice Hall – Practice Gymnasium, 1st Floor, Shaw Sports Complex, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, Hunghom, Kowloon, Hong Kong, China

3. **ENTRIES**
 - 3.1 Each team can enter one Men's Team and one Women's Team.
 - 3.2 Each team can enter 2 entries for each individual event. (Men's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Singles, Women's Doubles, and Mixed Doubles)
 - 3.3 Each player can enter up to 2 individual events and 1 team event.

4. **METHOD OF PLAY**
 - 4.1 **TEAM EVENTS**

The team events will be conducted in 2 stages.

 - In the first stage, the teams will play in groups of 3 or 4 teams on the basis of round robin system.
 - In the second stage, the teams will play by single knock-out system to determine the final placings.
 - The team events will be played in the best-of-five (5) matches.
 - All matches will be played in the best-of-five (5) games.

4.2 INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

(Men's Singles, Women's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles)

All individual events will be played by single knock-out system.

- All Singles matches will be played in the best-of-seven (7) games.
- All Doubles matches will be played in the best-of-five (5) games.

4.3 No BRONZE Medal match will be played.

5. DRAW

5.1 The draw for all events will take place immediately after the Team Managers' Meeting which is scheduled at 2:30 pm on 2 July, 2010 in Shaw Sports Complex, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University

5.2 Seeding

- Team: according to the latest ITTF Team Ranking.
- Singles: according to the latest ITTF Individual World Ranking.
- Doubles: according to the sum of the latest ITTF Individual World Ranking points.

6. RULES OF THE COMPETITION

The 2nd Asian University Table Tennis Championship will be played in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis and Regulations for International Competitions as published by the International Table Tennis Federation.

7. ADDITION OR ALTERATION OF PLAYERS

6.1 Addition or alteration of players' entries is not allowed after the deadline date of **21 June, 2010**.

6.2 In case of injury, a player may be substituted by another player already on the team list before **29 June, 2010**. Rules governing the maximum number of events per player still apply. **No substitution** is allowed **after 29 June, 2010**.

8. AWARDS

The Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runners-up will receive gold, silver and two bronze medals respectively.

9. **PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME**

The programme of the competitions will be determined by the Organizing Committee. In principle, the competition programme will last for up to four (4) days.

10. **FINANCIAL CONDITION**

10.1 Asian University Sports Federation (AUSF) registration fees:

AUSF shall receive from each person the following AUSF registration fees:

10.1.1 Effective member-associations of AUSF:

Ten U.S. Dollar (USD 10) per competitor and official;

10.1.2 Other associations:

Twenty U.S. Dollar (USD 20) per competitor and official; The AUSF registration fee will be collected by the CIC before the issues of the competitors' identity cards.

10.2 Participation fees:

The competing countries, upon arrival, shall pay their dues for participation fees USD40 (including food, accommodation, local transportation fees and sightseeing) as determined by the Executive Committee per day and per person to the Organizing Committee. A pre-payment of 25% of participation fee must be paid no later than 14 May 2010 (already due). **Upon arrival**, each country/region must **pay the remaining balance** to the OC.

11. ENTRIES AND CLOSING DATE

11.1 Prepayment of 25% of the participation fees must be paid no later than **14 May 2010 (already due)**.

*** The participation fee for all delegates (with a maximum of 10 competitors, 5 officials and 1 international umpire) has been approved by AUSF to be USD40 per person per day.
