

壁球 (2025-2026)

一、 賽制

- (a) 如參賽隊伍只有六隊或以下，採用單循環比賽。倘參賽隊伍有七隊或以上，則採用分組單循環比賽，以最佳成績之兩隊參加準決賽及決賽。每組第三，四名順序參加名次賽，如名次賽只有3隊，將舉行單循環賽以決定5-7名。
- (b) 男子組每場比賽共賽五盤，每盤比賽採五局三勝， 11分直接得分制。
女子組每場比賽共賽三盤，每盤比賽採五局三勝， 11分直接得分制。
- (c) 進行淘汰制時，倘準決賽、決賽及名次賽的勝負已分，比賽便算完結，無須完成男子5盤; 女子3盤所有賽事。
- (d) 每隊於報名時將球員按實力排次序，由強至弱排列，原則以PSA世界排名，香港成人排名，香港青少年排名 (所有排名以2025年10月1日當日公布後為準)及球員個人最近比賽表現作參考。如對某院校排名有異議，院校領隊可於公布後5個工作天內向執委會主席及賽事主委提出，賽會將成立一委員會審理，審理後為最終判決。
- (e) 每場比賽的記分紙按強至弱填寫球員名單，比賽前由主委、參賽院校負責人或裁判抽籤決定比賽場序。

二、 規則

除賽會特別訂明外，其他規則一律採用最新（該年度十月份）“世界壁球聯盟協會”編訂之規則。

三、 計分辦法

- (a) 初賽每場比賽勝出球隊可獲 1 分，而每位球員在勝出一盤比賽時亦可得 1 分，男子組每隊在一場賽事中最高可得 6 分，女子組每隊在一場賽事中最高可得 4 分。
- (b) 若初賽完結時出現同分情況，應採取以下決定名次:
 - i. 倘積分相同時，兩隊同分隊伍以勝者為勝
 - ii. 倘三隊或以上積分相同，應採取以下決定名次:
 - 首先計算有關隊伍相互比賽勝場次數，多者名次列前; 如勝場次數相同，則計算相同隊伍的對賽成績，勝者為勝。
 - 如仍未能分出勝負，則計算相關隊伍盤數之勝負差，多者名次列前。
 - 若仍未能分出勝負，則計算相關隊伍局數之勝負差，多者名次列前。
 - 倘再相同則計算相關隊伍每局分數之勝負差，多者名次列前。
 - 倘結果仍然相同，則由有關隊伍重賽（此項只適用於出線隊伍產生之情況下）。

四、 報名

- (a) 每院校限報男女子各一隊，運動員經填報後不得更改（包括資料及相片），報名表須經董事局成員簽署及蓋上院校印鑑。
- (b) 男子隊報名人數不得超過十一人及不少於五人。女子隊報名人數不得超過八人及不少於三人。
- (c) 需為全日制學生。
- (d) 運動員必須於1990年1月1日至2008年12月31日期間出生。

五、 改期

賽程經主委編定後，各院校不得要求改期。若有特別事故，主委有權更改賽期。

六、 裁判

由比賽主委聘請合格裁判擔任。

七、 棄權

- (a) 到達法定比賽時間，參賽隊伍未能派出合法人數出賽者（男不少於五人，女不少於三人），判作棄權論（以場地計時器為準）。
- (b) 球賽進行之任何爭議，倘已明文規定者或有同等意義註明者，由裁判判定，不得異議。比賽須繼續進行，如有隊伍放棄繼續比賽，作棄權論。
- (c) 棄權隊伍均須就棄權一事作書面解釋（比賽後七十二小時內“假期計算在內”）。該書面信函須由董事局成員簽署。

八、 抗議及上訴

賽後如有抗議提出上訴者，應在賽後七十二小時內（假期計算在內）以書面提出。該書面信函須由董事局成員簽署，連同保證金港幣三千元，送交比賽主委提出上訴，經由上訴委員會審判後為最終判決。

九、 天氣

如開賽前 2 小時，香港天文台已發出八號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號之預警、八號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號或黑色暴雨警告信號，當日全部賽事將取消，主委將另行安排補賽。

十、 附則

- (a) 比賽用球採用“DUNLOP”雙黃點壁球，由賽會提供。
- (b) 每一球員在一場比賽中祇能參加一盤比賽。
- (c) 所有選手都要佩帶合適的保護眼罩，方可出場比賽。
- (d) 本章程如有未盡善之處，主辦單位得隨時修訂，並提交大專執委會通過後實施。

Squash (2025-2026)

1. Format of Competition

- (a) A single round-robin system will be adopted in the preliminary round if the number of participating teams is six only. If the number of participating teams is more than six, teams will be drawn into two groups. The top two teams in each group will qualify for the final. Teams finishing at 3rd and 4th places in the groups will play for the consolation round, adopting the cross-elimination system. A single round-robin system will be adopted in the consolation round if the number of participating teams is three only.
- (b) In the preliminary round of men's competition, each match shall consist of five games. A game shall be played according to the best of five sets system. A set shall be won by the side which first scores 11 points by rally system (in deuce situation, a minimum lead of 2 points).
In the preliminary round of women's competition, each match shall consist of three games. A game shall be played according to the best of five sets system. A set shall be won by the side which first scores 11 points by rally point system (in a deuce situation, a minimum lead of 2 points).
- (c) In the semi-final, final and consolation rounds, the men's matches shall be played according to the best of five games system and the women's matches shall be played according to the best of three games system.
- (d) On the Entry Form and the Record Sheet, each institution has to rank the athletes according to their performance ability. In each match, the line-up of the team shall be arranged according to the ranking order from the highest to the lowest. Priority is given to the following rankings: PSA World Ranking, Hong Kong National Ranking and Hong Kong Junior Ranking (announced on or after 1 Oct 2025) and recent performance of the individual player. Appeal can be made within 5 working days by writing to the convenor and chairman of the executive committee. All appeals will be handled by the seeding panel committee which will make the final decision.
- (e) The referee or convenor will draw to decide the order of the match prior to the start of the match.

2. Regulations

Unless otherwise stated, the competition shall be organized in accordance with the most recent (until October) technical regulations of the "World Squash Federation" (WSF)

3. Scoring

- (a) In the preliminary round, one point shall be awarded for winning in a match and in each game. A maximum of six points in a match for a Men's team and four points for a Women's team.
- (b) In case of equality in ranking between teams in the preliminary round, the following shall be adopted to decide the position:
 - i/ If a tie exists between two teams, the team that wins in a match shall be accorded a higher position;
 - ii/ If a tie exists among three teams or more, the position shall be decided by:
 - The team that wins more matches shall be accorded a higher position; If the tie exists, the ranking shall base on the match difference (number of matches won minus matches lost) during the matches played among the teams, the team with the larger difference shall be ranked higher;
 - If a tie exists, the ranking shall base on the game difference (number of games won minus games lost) during the matches played among the teams, the team with the larger difference shall be ranked higher;
 - If a tie still exists, the ranking shall base on the set difference (number of sets won minus sets lost) during the matches played among the teams, the team with the larger difference shall be ranked higher;
 - When a tie still exists among the teams on set difference, the position shall be decided by point difference (number of points scored minus points lost) during the matches played among the teams, the team with the larger difference shall be ranked higher;
 - If the results are still the same, teams concerned will play against each other again (only applicable in situation relating to advancement to final and consolation rounds).

- 4. Entries**
- (a) Each institution is entitled to enter one men's team and one women's team. The personal information with recent photos of the student-athletes should be put down clearly on the enrollment form, duly signed by the Council Member of the respective institution with school chop. The personal information of the student-athletes (including details and photos) cannot be changed after the submission of the entry form.
 - (b) A men's team may consist of a maximum of eleven and a minimum of five players; A women's team may consist of a maximum of eight and a minimum of three players.
 - (c) Eligibility of student-athletes: registered for full-time studies at the respective institutions.
 - (d) All student-athletes must be born from 01/01/1990 to 31/12/2008.
- 5. Postponement**
- Request for postponement will not be entertained. Under special circumstances, the convenor has the right to change the competition schedule.
- 6. Referees**
- Qualified/Certified referees/markers will be recruited/ hired for the referee/markings services by convenor.
- 7. Withdrawal**
- (a) Any team that does not present a minimum number of players (not less than 5 for Men; not less than 3 for Women) required for a particular game at the scheduled competition start time (according to the timing system of venue) shall be disqualified for the match.
 - (b) During a match, the decision of the referee made according to the relevant rules of squash shall be final. Should a team oppose the decision and refuse to play, the team shall be taken as withdrawing from the match.
 - (c) The team withdrawn should submit an official explanation signed by the Council Member of the institution concerned to the Chairman of the Executive Committee of USFHK within 72 hours (irrespective of holidays) of the event.
- 8. Protests and Appeals**
- Each and every appeal must be made in writing and signed by the Council Member of the institution concerned. The appeal, accompanied with a deposit of Hong Kong dollars three thousand, shall be made within 72 hours (irrespective of holidays) of the event concerned, to the convenor and copied to the Chairman of Executive Committee. The decision of the Appeal Board shall be final.
- 9. Weather**
- If, two hours before the start of competitions/events, the Hong Kong Observatory issues a No. 8 or higher tropical cyclone warning signal or its pre-warning, or a black rainstorm warning signal, all competitions/events for that day will be canceled, and the convenor will arrange for rescheduling.
- 10. By-laws and Rules**
- (a) The "DUNLOP PRO Double Yellow Dot Squash Ball" is adopted as the official ball of the competition and shall be supplied by the Federation.
 - (b) Each student-athlete can only participate in one game of a match only.
 - (c) All student-athletes must wear suitable eye-goggles during the match.
 - (d) The organizer reserves the right to amend and/or supplement the By-Laws, Rules and Regulations. The By-Laws, Rules and Regulations thus made will be submitted to the Executive Committee for approval before adoption.
 - (e) In case of controversy over the rules/regulations between the Chinese and the English versions, the interpretation of the Chinese version shall be followed.
