

網 球（2025-2026）

一、 賽制

- (a) 如參加之單位只有六隊或以下，將採用單循環比賽。倘參加之單位有七隊或以上，則採用分組單循環比賽，以最佳成績之兩隊參加準決賽及決賽。每組第三，四名順序參加名次賽，全部採用交叉淘汰制。
- (b) 每場比賽五盤（包括三個單打、兩個雙打），以先勝三盤者為勝。
- (c) 比賽次序：(i) 第一單打 (ii) 第二單打 (iii) 第一雙打 (iv) 第二雙打 (v) 第三單打
- (d) 初賽採用一盤六局制，當一盤積分雙方達到六比六時，即採用“七分決勝局”以定勝負。名次賽、準決賽及決賽採用八局長盤制，當一盤積分雙方達到八比八時，即採用“七分決勝局”以定勝負。

二、 規則

除賽會特別訂明外，其他規則一律採用最新（該年度九月份）國際網球協會編訂之規則。

三、 計分辦法

- (a) 單循環比賽勝一場得 2 分，負一場得 1 分，棄權或被取消資格得 0 分。
- (b) 倘積分相同時，兩隊同分隊伍以勝者為勝。倘三隊或以上積分相同，首先計算有關隊伍相互比勝場次數多者名次列前。如勝場次數相同，則計算相同隊伍的對賽成績，勝者為勝。如仍未能分出勝負，則計算相關隊伍盤數之勝負差，多者名次列前。若仍未能分出勝負，則計算相關隊伍局數之勝負差，多者名次列前。倘再相同則計算相關隊伍每局分數之勝負差，多者名次列前（計算公式：勝負差 = 得盤 / 局 / 分 - 失盤 / 局 / 分）。
- (c) 倘結果仍然相同，則由有關隊伍重賽（此項只適用於出線隊伍產生之情況下）。

四、 報名

- (a) 每院校限報男女子各一隊，運動員經填報後不得更改（包括資料及相片），報名表須經董事局成員簽署及蓋上院校印鑑。
- (b) 每隊報名人數不得超過十人及不得少於四人。
- (c) 運動員出生日期：1/1/1990 – 31/12/2008

五、 改期

賽程經主委編定後，各院校不得要求改期。若有特別事故，主委有權更改賽期。

六、 裁判

由比賽主委聘請合格裁判擔任，如有須要出賽隊伍須負責派出司線員（熟識球例者）協助裁判工作。

七、 棄權

- (a) 到達法定比賽時間，參賽隊伍未能派出合法人數出賽者（不少於四人），判作棄權論（法定時間以大會場地時鐘 / 司令台電子鐘為準）。
- (b) 所有參賽隊伍必須於法定比賽時間前十分鐘提交出場表。出場表一經遞交後，不得更改。出場表上的作賽球員，必須於法定比賽時間前親臨向主委報到及核實身份，否則判作棄權論（以主委計時器為準）。
- (c) 球賽進行之中之任何爭議，倘已明文規定者或有同等意義註明者，由裁判判定，不得異議。比賽須繼續進行，如有隊伍放棄繼續比賽，作棄權論。
- (d) 棄權隊伍均須就棄權一事作書面解釋（比賽後七十二小時內“假期計算在內”）。該書面信函須由董事局成員簽署。

八、 抗議及上訴

賽後如有抗議提出上訴者，應在賽後七十二小時內（假期計算在內）以書面提出。該書面信函須由董事局成員簽署，連同保證金港幣三仟圓，送交比賽主委提出上訴，經由上訴委員會審判後為最終判決。

九、 天氣

舉行比賽當日如遇惡劣天氣，主委有權決定賽事應否依期舉行。如在比賽進行中遇到惡劣天氣致使比賽不能進行，則改期續賽，已賽成績有效。

十、 附則

- (a) 比賽用球採用“Dunlop AO”網球，每次比賽各隊自備三筒作賽。
- (b) 每一球員在每場比賽中祇能參加一場單打及一場雙打賽事。
- (c) 第一單打及第二單打之球員不能參加該隊的第一雙打。
- (d) 本章程如有未盡善之處，主辦單位得隨時修訂，並提交大專執委會通過後實施。

Tennis (2025-2026)

1. Format of Competition

- (a) A single round-robin system will be adopted in the preliminary round if the number of participating teams is six only. If the number of participating teams is more than six, teams will be drawn into two groups. The top two teams in each group will qualify for the final. Teams finishing in 3rd and 4th places in the groups will play for the consolation round, adopting the cross-elimination system.
- (b) A tie shall consist of the best of five matches (three singles and two doubles).
- (c) Order of Play: (i) 1st Singles (ii) 2nd Singles (iii) 1st Doubles (iv) 2nd Doubles (v) 3rd Singles.
- (d) A normal set will be played in each set, in case of six games all, a 7-point tie-break will be played to decide the match in the preliminary round.
Pro-set match will be played in each set, in case of eight games all, a 7-point tie-break will be played in the semi-final, final and consolation rounds.

2. Regulations

Unless otherwise stated, the competition shall be organized in accordance with the latest (until last September) edition of the International Tennis Federation.

3. Scoring

- (a) Winning a tie will score 2 points in the single round robin competition, loss 1 point, and 0 point for abstaining and disqualification.
- (b) If two teams have won the same points, the winner of the tie between them will be ranked higher. If three or more teams have won the same points, ranking will be established by the total ties won, with more ties won ranked higher. As total ties won are the same, ranking will be established by the difference between total matches won and total matches lost, with greater difference ranked higher. If this is still equal, ranking will be established by the difference between total games won and total games lost, with greater difference ranked higher. If this is still equal, ranking will be established by the difference between total points won and total points lost of each game, with greater difference ranked higher. (calculating formula: difference between won & lost = matches / games / points won – matches / games / points lost).
- (c) If the results are still the same, a replay will be arranged for the teams concerned. (this item only applies to the teams in the preliminary round)

4. Entries

- (a) Each institution is entitled to enter one men's team and one women's team. After completing the enrollment, players' details cannot be changed (including data and photograph), the enrollment form must be signed by a Council Member of the USFHK with the College's seal on the cover.
- (b) A team may consist of 4 to 10 players.
- (c) Age restriction to players: date of birth from 1/1/1990 to 31/12/2008.

5. Rescheduling

After the competition fixture has been confirmed by the Convener, request for rescheduling will not be entertained. Under special circumstances, the convener has the right to change the fixture.

6. Umpires

Convener will employ qualified umpires for judging services but the racing team shall be responsible for sending line judges (those familiar with rules) to assist the judging services.

7. Withdrawal

- (a) Any team does not present a minimum number of players (not less than four) required for a particular game at the scheduled competition start time (according to the timing system of venue / clock on the official table). Shall be disqualified for the match.
- (b) All teams are required to submit the player list 10 minutes prior to the scheduled match start time. Once the player list has been submitted, no changes are allowed. Should there be any discrepancies to the original player list or order of the list, the concerned team would be considered losing the game(s).
- (c) In case of any dispute, the referees reserve the sole right to make the final decision. Should a team refuse to play after the decision, the opposing team shall be awarded a walk-over.
- (d) The walk-over team should forward an explanation letter signed by a Council Member of the respective institution to USFHK within 72 hours (including holiday) after the match.

8. Protest and Appeal

Appeals shall be made in writing within 72 hours after the game (holidays included). The writing has to be signed by the members of the Board of Directors, together with a deposit of HKD three thousand. Appeals shall be sent to the Convener of the event, and the decision of the Appeal Committee is final.

9. Weather

In case of adverse weather before the match, the Convener has the right to decide whether the event should be held on time. If the matches cannot be completed as scheduled due to adverse weather, rescheduling will be arranged, all results will be retained.

10. By-law and Rules

- (a) "Dunlop AO" tennis ball is used as the official ball of the competition. Three cans of tennis balls should be provided by each team for the competition.
- (b) Each player in each tie can only participate in one Singles and one Doubles.
- (c) First Singles and second Singles players cannot participate in the first Doubles.
- (d) The organizer reserves the right to amend and/or supplement the By-Laws, Rules and Regulations. The By-Laws, Rules and Regulations thus made will be submitted to the Executive Committee for approval.
- (e) The Chinese version will be followed for any inconsistency in the English and Chinese versions of the regulations.
